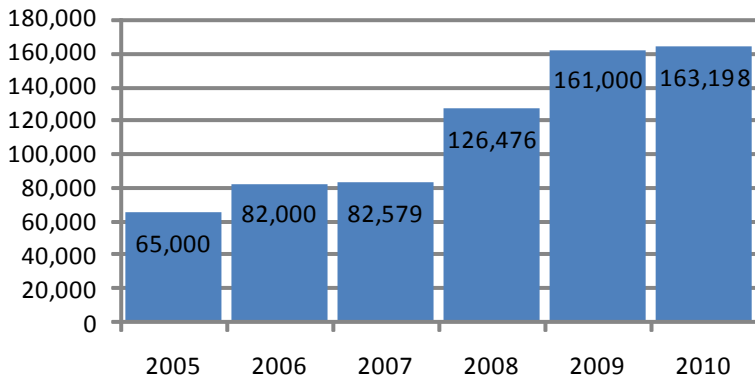

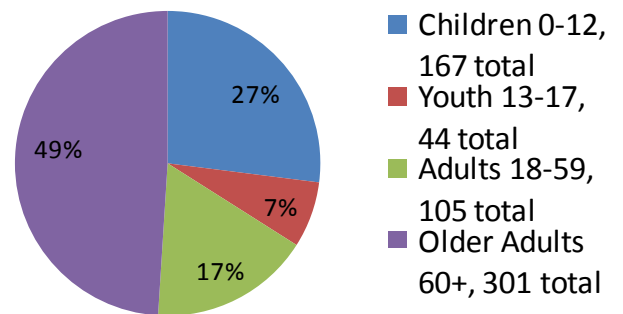
The year began with Trinity's annual fundraising event, Dancing Through the Decades in February. Check out our winners for best dressed!

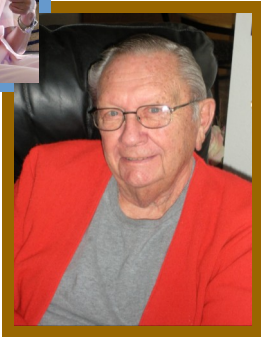
